The Eligibility Requirements

- Full-time enrollment in an Associate's or Bachelor's degree program**
- Minimum high school GPA of 3.50
- Prior academic excellence

The Next Steps

Complete Honors Program application by **June 1, 2027**. You must include:

- One written essay
- Evidence of past academic achievements
- Resume
- Letters of recommendation
- Unofficial transcripts proving GPA and credits

Cannot be combined with any other Berkeley College grants or scholarships. There are 20 scholarships available for students attending a campus in New York and 20 scholarships available for students attending a campus in New Jersey or Online.

**Students enrolled in a certificate or degree program within the School of Health Studies are not eligible to apply or participate in the Honors Program.

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
