Admission Requirements

1. Online Application
2. \$50 Application Fee
3. Official secondary or post-secondary transcripts
4. Proof of graduation
5. Proof of English proficiency
 - TOEFL – IBT 61 or higher
 - IELTS – 5.5 or higher
 - Other English tests are acceptable
 - ESL certificate of appropriate level from approved ESL program
6. Official document of financial support demonstrating a minimum of \$43,000 (USD) in available funds
7. Scholarship application form (If applicable)

*After receiving an admission decision, a \$100 international processing fee and a \$300 refundable tuition deposit will be required to confirm your admission and to receive the Official Acceptance Packet with your I-20 document.

For students who do not meet English language proficiency requirements:
